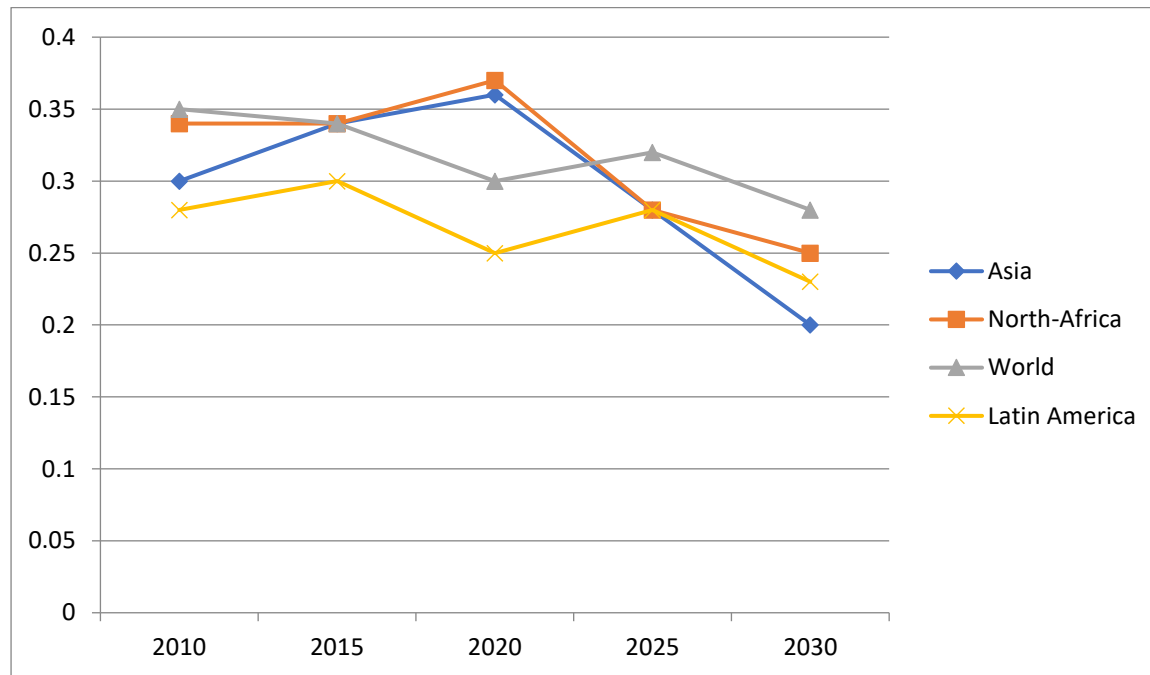


Figure 1 depicts youth ages as population proportion and projected decline in further decades.

(the best-fit relapse line for emerging nations has a negative incline). More-created nations have a much lesser youth proportion than less-created nations, however, they don't have below employability overall.

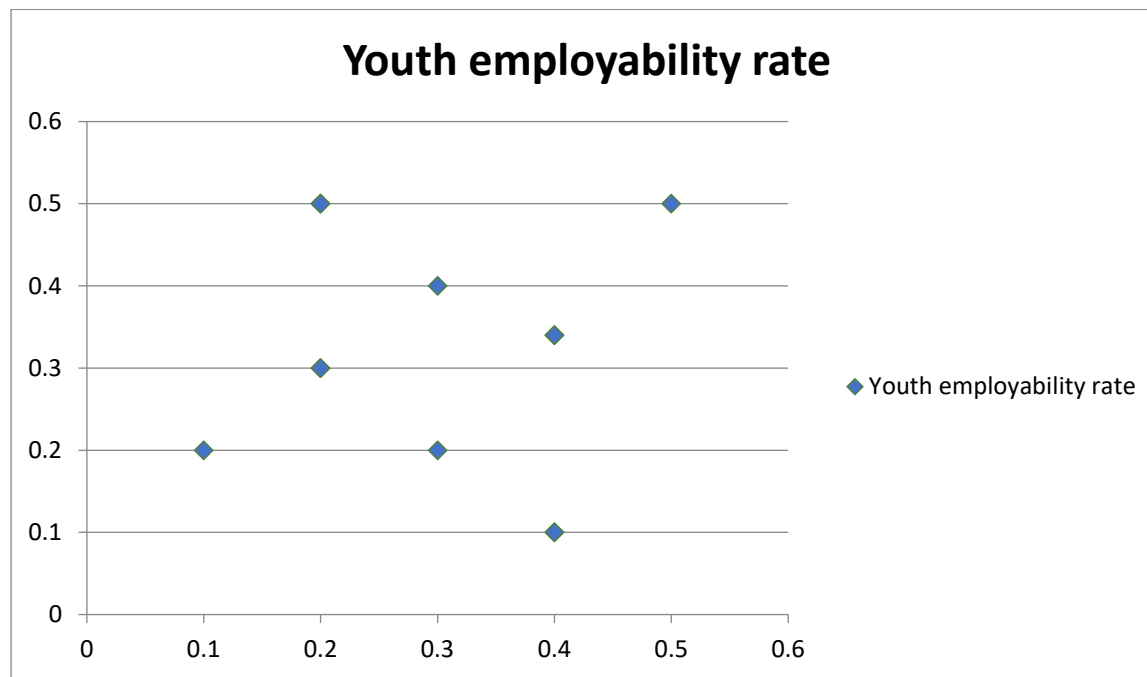


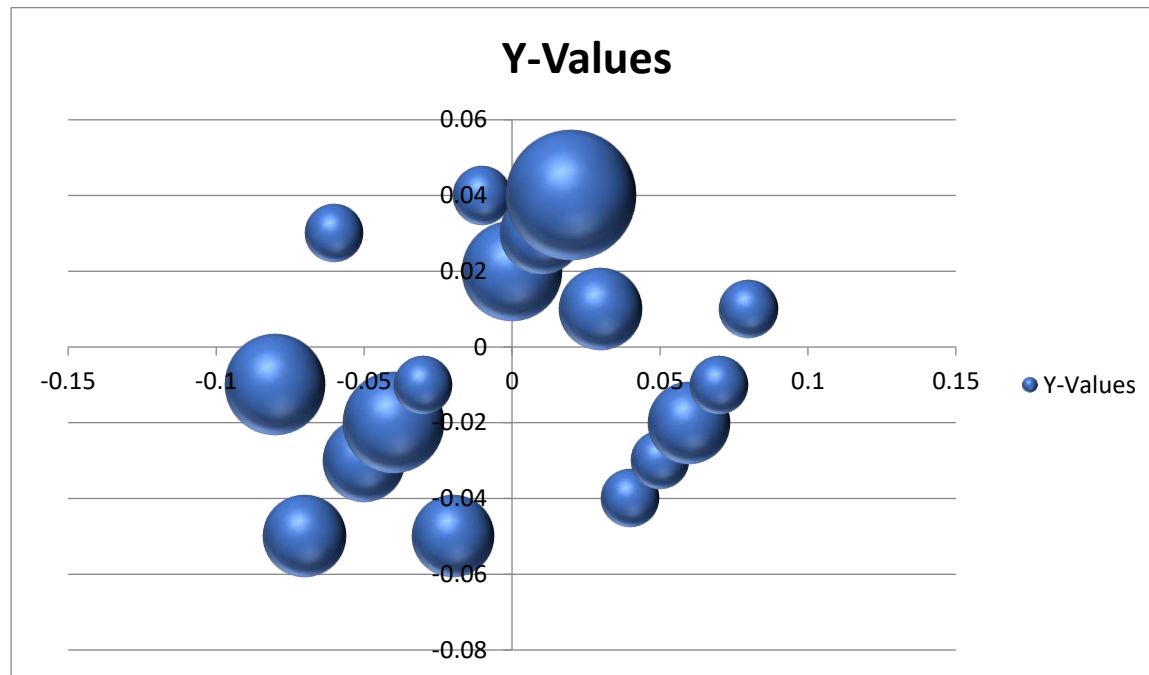
